

**2006 BAYOU RIFLES INC. PISTOL TOURNAMENT SCHEDULE
HOUSTON, TEXAS**

MATCHES DATES: The 2700 Standard pistol course is fired on the fourth Sunday of each month, unless otherwise noted. Matches are approved by the National Rifle Association unless otherwise noted. Match dates are: Jan 22, Feb 26, March 26, April 23, May 28, June 25, July 23, Aug 27, Sept 24 Oct 22, and Nov 26.

RANGE LOCATION AND FACILITY: Bayou Rifles is located on the east side of Eldridge Parkway (Exit 753a) approximately 1/2 mile north of I-10 in the 13000 block, between marker 752 and 753, ten miles west of the I-10/610 west intersection. The range has covered shooting positions on a concrete slab firing line, individual shooting stands, and a wooden wind break fence behind the firing line. The 25 yard targets are mechanically operated for sustained fire.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to any member of the National Rifle Association.

RULES: Current NRA Conventional Pistol Rules will govern.

TIME OF FIRING: Firing commences at 9:00 AM.

MATCH FEES: One gun - \$10, two guns - \$15, three guns - \$20. All fees include NRA registration.

SQUADDING: Matches will be squadded when there is more than one relay, or when deemed necessary by the range officials.

METHOD OF FIRE: The entire match will be fired in one day. There will be a short break after the 22 match and a 45-minute lunch break after the centerfire match.

CATEGORIES AND CLASSIFICATION: The NRA classification system will be used in all matches. Unclassified shooters will fire in the Master Class. Less than three entries in a category class will be combined with entries of another category within the same class.

ENTRIES: Registration is limited to 40 competitors. Shooters entering the full program will be given preference if range space becomes critical. Entries to be paid by a military unit or sponsor must have written authorization and billing instructions at the time of registration. For further information contact:

AWARDS: Winner and class awards will receive NRA award points only. Individual match winners will not receive a class award. If there are less than 3 competitors in a class, there will be no award in that class and all competitors will be moved to the next higher class within their respective category. Awards will be mailed with the match bulletin; no other awards will be available. Class awards will be as follows:

1st Place	3 Competitors
2nd Place	7 Competitors
3rd Place	11 Competitors

SCHEDULE CHANGES: Prevailing weather conditions may necessitate a change in the course of fire. Division officers will announce any program modifications prior to the start of the match.

SCORE CHALLENGES: A challenge fee of \$1.00 will be charged for each target challenged. The fee will be returned if the challenge is upheld.

MATCH BULLETIN: The match bulletin will become final 24 hours after completion of the match. All competitors will receive a copy of the final bulletin by regular mail.

CONCESSIONAIRE: There will be no concessionaire at the range; however, there are suitable eating places within easy driving distance of the range and suitable time (45 min.) will be allowed during the lunch break. **Running water at the range is not potable and should not be consumed.**
