The Vicki Jockers Memorial Scholarship match

Vicki Jockers was a devoted wife, mother of two, and a grandmother to seven. She was a life member of the Faith United Church of Christ in Grantville, PA and spent her professional life as a 5th grade school teacher in the Northern Lebanon school district where she taught and mentored generations of kids. After her retirement, she continued to work with the public through her church as well as working at Indian echo caverns and giving tours at the Hershey story.

She was a strong advocate of People furthering themselves through all forms of education. Not only did she support college, but she also supported trade schools and apprenticeships. When she was 82 years old, she was abruptly and unexpectedly diagnosed with Asbestosis. After a two-year ordeal, she peacefully lost this battle with her family by her side.

The Jockers family has been involved in the competitive sport of Olympic-style shooting and has decided to honor our grandmother by supporting something that was very close to her heart: the continued education of young adults. We and others are sponsoring a 60 shot standing air rifle and a three-position smallbore match with special scholarship awards in her honor. In each match there will also be regular category and class awards.

The match will be held at the Palmyra Sportsman Association on May 8th and 9th. A 60-shot Smallbore (.22 cal.) three-position and a 60-shot Air Rifle Standing match will be held on the club's indoor facilities on SUIS electric targets. On the 20 firing point Outdoor Competition range, a Re-entry 1200 prone match will be held on Sunday as well as 100 yard Fun matches in both prone and standing in the afternoons each day. The Vicki Jockers Memorial Scholarship as well as others will also benefit from the profits of the outdoor matches.

All of the matches throughout the weekend are open to anyone with awards given out to the overall winners as well as different age groups and classifications as appropriate (see specific match program). The Vicki Jockers Scholarships will be awarded to 11th and 12th graders. Scholarships awards will be given to the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place shooters ranging from \$150 to \$1000. In addition to a cash prize, the prone match winner will have their name engraved onto a uniquely designed trophy that will be displayed in the club's trophy case.

This is the first and only match of its type in the country. All the profits from match fees, food sales, raffles, and donations throughout the weekend will be added to the scholarship awards. We expect that this will be a tremendous weekend and we hope that you can attend and make the Scholarship match a recurring competition in upcoming years.

NCAA Eligibility

The prizes and scholarships given at this competition are allowed to be taken by juniors and those athletes still retain their ability to compete on NCAA rifle teams as long as the necessary expenses for “practice and competition” do not outweigh the winnings from the event. Please see the NCAA Rules below. Also, note the last Rule 12.02.03 that expenses are calculated “during each calendar year (January—December), rather than on an event-by-event basis.” This allows the monetary prizes to be taken by juniors during this competition and retain their NCAA Eligibility. This has been confirmed through a NCAA coach.

12.1.2.4 Exceptions to Amateurism Rule

12.1.2.4.1 Exception for Prize Money Based on Performance—Sports Other Than Tennis

In sports other than tennis, an individual may accept prize money based on his or her place finish or performance in an athletics event. Such prize money may not exceed actual and necessary expenses and may be provided only by the sponsor of the event. The calculation of actual and necessary expenses shall not include the expenses or fees of anyone other than the individual (e.g., coach’s fees or expenses, family member’s expenses).

12.02.2 Actual and Necessary Expenses. Actual and necessary expenses are limited to: (Adopted: 1/19/13 effective 8/1/13)

- (a) Meals;
- (b) Lodging;
- (c) Apparel, equipment and supplies;
- (d) Coaching and instruction;
- (e) Health/medical insurance;
- (f) Transportation (expenses to and from practice and competition, cost of transportation from home to training/practice site at the beginning of the season/preparation for an event and from training/practice/event site to home at the end of season/event);
- (g) Medical treatment and physical therapy; 8/7/20 61
- (h) Facility usage;
- (i) Entry fees; and
- (j) Other reasonable expenses.

12.02.3 Calculation of Actual and Necessary Expenses—Individual Sports

In individual sports, the calculation of an individual’s actual and necessary expenses shall be based on **expenses incurred during each calendar year** (January—December), rather than on an event-by-event basis.

Vicki Jockers Memorial Scholarship

All of the Scholarship awards will be paid directly to the school that the winning athlete will be attending by the Palmyra Sportsmen’s Association. Scholarship recipients will therefore need to provide information for their college/university or technical school to the club. Athletes, which do not know their future college or school (Juniors), will provide the needed information at the time of their future decision. Until then Palmyra Sportsmen’s Association will hold the funds for those recipients.

Sights: Metallic sights for Juniors, Any Sights for Open
Ranges: Covered, 108' by 32', 5' wide firing points, 20 firing points total
Targets: 50 yards (A-23), **50 meters (A-26)**, and 100 yards (A-25) targets
Eligibility: The match is open to all interested individuals. Any rifle, Rule 3.2.

Fees: Individual fired matches may be fired at \$12 per fired match. Make checks payable to "Palmyra Sportsmen's Association." Fee breakdown: Club registration \$2.00, Match fees \$10.00. Any fired match may be re-entered for \$12. Competitors entered in all fired matches (Matches 1-3) are eligible for aggregate (Match 4) awards. Competitors entered in all fired matches (Matches 1-3) will receive a free lunch ticket. If a competitor enters a fired match multiple times, their highest score will count towards awards for the fired match and the aggregate match.

Food: Excellent food will be served throughout the day with the proceeds going towards the scholarship fund.

Breakfast:

Doughnuts, muffins, and coffee will be available

Lunch/Dinner:

Slow smoked pulled pork will be cooked on the site of the day of the match. Side dishes of macaronic and cheese, baked beans, cole slaw, and chips will also be available.

Hamburgers and chesseburgers will also be available for purchase.

Protests on Electronic Targets: For Smallbore see rule USAS 6.15.4.2. Briefly, if a shooter contests the value of a shot, a protest will only be accepted when made before the next shot or if it is the last shot, within three (3) minutes. If a protest is made concerning the value of a shot, the shooter will be requested to fire another shot at the end of the competition, so that this extra shot may be counted if the protest is upheld and the correct value of the disputed shot cannot be determined. If the protest concerning a shot value other than zero, or failure to register, is not upheld, a two (2) point penalty from the score of the disputed shot will be awarded. The protest fee is \$0.

Challenges on Paper Targets: \$1.00 fee per match for a competitor's own targets; \$3.00 fee per match for another competitor's targets. Challenges must be made prior to the challenge period ending. The fee is returned if the score changes.

Vendors: Vendors are welcome to set up their wares, but must be coordinated ahead of the match dates. A small donation or fee may be asked for the competiton. Please contact Erin Gestl for details.

Safety: Open Bolt Indicators or Clear Barrel Indicators will be used when rifles are out of their cases. If needed, OBIs or CBIs are available for use during the match at no charge.

Compressed air is available at the range at no charge. CO₂ is not available.

Accommodations: Please check the website, <https://www.palmyrasportsmens.com/Contact> for a listing of several hotels in the area. Tenting or RVs on clubhouse grounds is allowed at no charge or a small donation. Electrical hook-ups are possible. Please contact Erin to make arrangements.

Directions to Palmyra: From North and East: Take 78W to 81S to 934S, Fort Indiantown Gap exit to Annville. Take 422W (right) into Palmyra. After the Sheetz gas station on the right, turn right at the next light onto Forge Rd. See directions below. **From South:** Take the turnpike west and get off at the Lebanon exit. Take 72N and then 322W. In Campbelltown turn right onto 117N (Forge Rd.) into Palmyra. Go straight across 422 at the light (Forge Rd). See the directions below. **From West:** Take 322E until you reach Hershey, but do not get off at the Hershey Medical Center (Ephrata) exit, keep going straight and 422E will begin. Follow 422E into Palmyra. After you pass Railroad St., turn left at the second light (Forge Rd.). See the directions below. **Directions Continued for all:** Once on Forge Rd., go about 1.8 miles; as the road makes a very sharp left, a small road (Sportsman Road) goes straight. Take the small road (Sportsman Road) and 0.2 miles later the club sign is overhead. The clubhouse is located at the bottom of the hill. For GPS purposes (not mailing), use the address: 410 Sportsmens Road, Annville, PA 17003.
